## AIDRU - GRIDAUH prize rules

Art. 1 The International Association of Land Use Planning Law (AIDRU) and the Groupement de recherche sur les institutions et le droit de l'aménagement, de l'urbanisme et de l'habitat (GRIDAUH) award every two year the AIDRU GRIDAUH prize to a legal essay in the field of land use planning law.

Art. 2 Submitted essays must relate to the theme of the AIDRU conference held the year of the award of the prize. They must include an aspect of comparative law.

Art. 3 Every two years the AIDRU Secretary General sets the date for the submission of the essays. This date is published on the AIDRU and GRIDAUH websites.

Art. 4 The submitted essays shall have a single author. They can be written in French or in English. They must not have been previously published or selected for publication. Papers (thesis) presented as training assignements are eligible.

Art. 5 The essays should not be longer than $60^{\prime} 000$ characters, spaces included. They should be sent to the AIDRU General Secretariat in electronic form (pdf format) before the set deadline.

Art. 6 The prize is awarded by a jury of three experts in comparative land use planning law, appointed respectively by the AIDRU General Secretariat, the GRIDAUH directorate and the person in charge of organizing the AIDRU conference. The award is announced at least three months before the conference.

Art. 7 The amount of the prize is 500 euros. The author of the prize winning essay is invited to the conference, expenses paid by the organizers, to receive the prize and to briefly present the essay.

Art. 8 The prize-winning essay is published in the proceedings of the conference.
